

Questions to ask students about their day:

The Weekly food menu is posted inside Preschool One, on our Parent Information Board and included in the Monday Memos.

Questions:

- What was your least favorite thing to eat for breakfast/lunch/snack?
- What fruit did you have for breakfast/lunch/snack?
- What vegetable did you have for breakfast/lunch/snack?
- What fruit or vegetable or food did you try for breakfast/lunch/snack?
- What is one thing you ate for breakfast/lunch/snack that you never had before?
- Who did you sit with at breakfast/lunch/snack?
- Who were the table setters for breakfast/lunch/snack?
- Who were the table wipers for breakfast/lunch/snack?
- What was your favorite thing to eat at breakfast/lunch/snack?

A What in the World Happened Today synopsis of the activities the students engaged in that day are posted inside the Preschool One classroom on our Parent Information Board as well as sent to you via the My Bright Day App Monday thru Thursday

Questions:

- What activity was your favorite to do in class??
- Who did you complete an activity with?
- Pick a specific activity off the What in the World Happen Today and ask your child about it. (Did you do this activity? Are you interested in this topic? Do you want to complete this activity again?)
- What did you practicing writing in school today?
- When did you use a pencil at school today?
- What would you teach the class if you were the teacher?

The students engage in circle times in the morning and afternoon.

Questions:

- Who came to school today?
- Who did not come to school today?
- What book did you read today?
- What is your favorite part of the book?
- What was your classroom responsibility?
- What is your favorite book for the teacher to read?
- What was in the sensory table today?

- What was your favorite center to engage in today?
- Who did you not like sitting by in circle time?
- Who do you like to sit by in circle time?

The students engage in several activities during outside play each day.

Questions:

- What did you do outside on the playground?
- Did you slide?
- Did you play tag with friends?
- Did you throw a ball?
- Who did you throw a ball with?
- Did you swing?
- Who did you swing with?
- Did you ride a bike?
- Did you ride a scooter?
- Did you climb the rope wall?
- Who did you climb the rope wall with?
- Did you climb the rock wall?
- Who did you climb the rock wall with?
- What did you build in the sand box?
- Who did you build something in the sandbox with?
- Did you race friends today?

Students experience a lot of emotions during the day.

Questions:

- What made you laugh today?
- What made your teacher smile today?
- What made you sad today?
- What made you feel happy today?
- Did you tell anyone thank you today?
- Did you tell anyone "I'm sorry" today?
- What was your least favorite part of the day?
- Who did you rest next to at nap time?
- Did you help anyone today?
- Were you kind today?
- What was the hardest rule to follow today?
- How did someone help you today?
- Who in your class were you nice to?
- Who in your class could you be nicer today?
- Who was nice to you in class?
- What was the funniest thing that happened in class today?
- What made you smile today?
