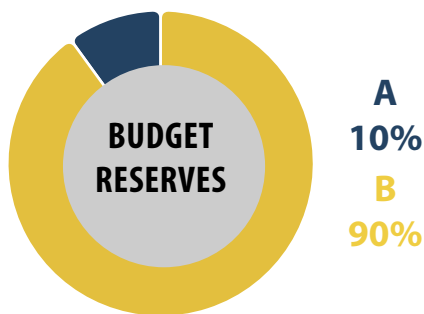




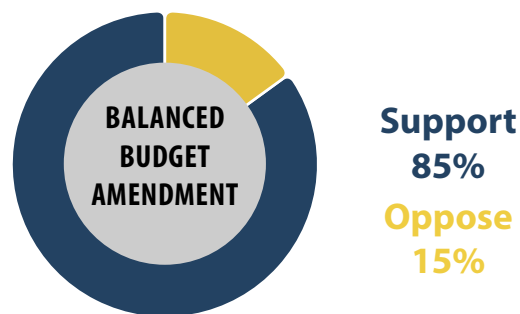
# 2017 SURVEY RESULTS

## STATE SENATOR JIM BUCK

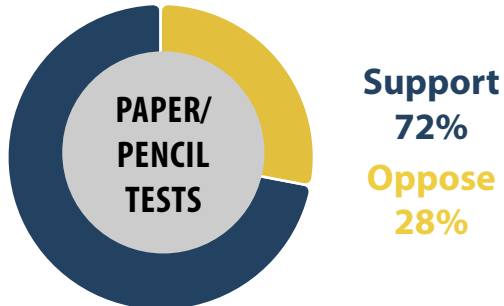

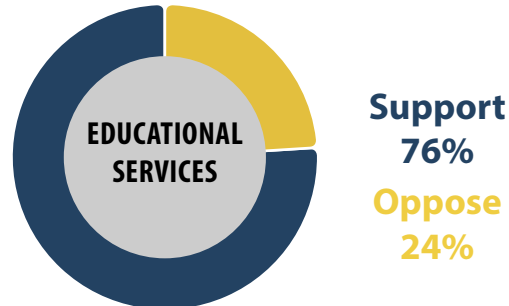
- 2.** Do you support or oppose amending the Indiana Constitution to require the General Assembly to pass a balanced budget?



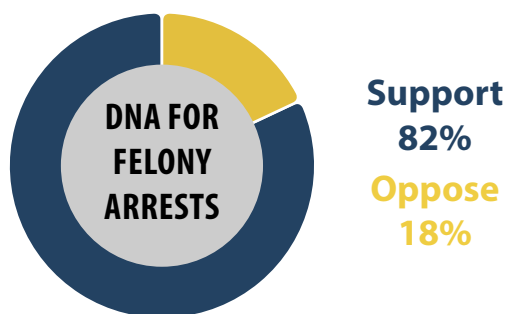
