Indiana State Sen. Mark Messmer has served Southern Indiana Hoosiers for the past nine years. Messmer served in the Indiana House of Representatives from 2008-2014 and was elected to the Senate in 2014, where he continues to serve today.

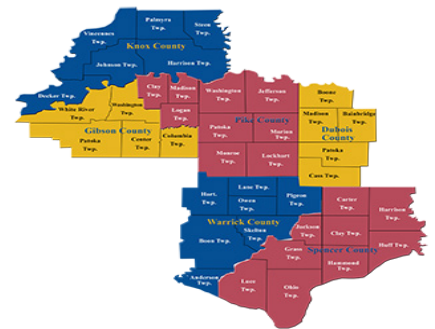
As a state senator, Messmer represents District 48, which includes all of Pike and Spencer counties along with portions of Dubois, Gibson, Knox and Warrick counties.

Messmer serves as the Majority Whip and is the Chair of the Senate Committee on Commerce and Technology. He also sits on the Senate Committees on Agriculture, Public Policy, and Natural Resources and is the Ranking Member on the Senate Committee on Utilities.

Professionally, Messmer is the co-owner of Messmer Mechanical, Inc., and holds a bachelor's degree from Purdue University in Mechanical Engineering.

Messmer's civic involvement isn't limited to just his service in the General Assembly. He is a member and previous officer of the Jasper Kiwanis Club, an officer in the Knights of Columbus, a member of the Evansville Chapter of the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers, and was previously the Chairman of the society's Government Affairs Committee.

Messmer resides in Jasper with his wife, Kim. He has four children.
