In 2019, the LA Phil will set off on an extraordinary global tour, with residencies in six cities, performing on three continents. All six cities will premiere John Adams' new piano concerto *Must the Devil Have All the Good Tunes?*, with Yuja Wang as soloist.

This global tour commences during the 18/19 Centennial celebrations with Spring visits to Seoul, South Korea and Tokyo, Japan. Three signature programs will be presented, including works by Gustav Mahler, John Williams and John Adams.

The LA Phil will also participate in the Edinburgh International Festival in Scotland in August 2019, with further performances in Mexico City, Mexico; London, England; and New York City, U.S.A. in the fall of 2019 – full details of these dates to be announced.
