
What is Minimalist Music?

John Adams is a minimalist composer, but what does that mean? Minimalist music is about small things like a simple pattern, rhythm, or melody that is repeated. One way to understand minimalist techniques is to see them represented visually.

PATTERN & CHANGE

Minimalist music uses lots of patterns that repeat. Patterns change, sometimes slowly and sometimes fast, into other patterns.



RHYTHM


Many patterns have different rhythms, so you'll hear multiple patterns happening at the same time.



TEXTURES


Music can be heavy and dense, with many instruments playing at once, or it can be light with only a few instruments playing a simple melody.

Music has different textures.



COLOR

Each instrument has its own unique sound. Sound can be like color. In minimalist music, the patterns repeated by different instruments create a range of colors.
