

## **Greetings!**

If you're receiving this, you have pre-registered for the NOLA Test and Tune on Thursday March 22, 2018. This event is open to race cars only and will be a 4-hour open session on track from 1pm-5pm. No run groups and you can enter and exit the track as often as you need to. We will be running the same configuration NASA and PCA will be running that weekend (2.75 mile configuration with the esses).

Registration/check-in opens at 11am and closes at 3pm on Thursday (3/22). Registration/check-in is located at the front gate in the office behind the flagpoles (next door to the security lanes). Even though you have preregistered online, you still need to check in at registration to sign the waiver, receive your wristband (good for the Thursday T&T only), and your techsheet. Your run sticker will be given to you when your tech sheet is turned in at registration/check-in. There is NO tech line for the T&T – the tech sheet is a self-tech.

Grid is at the far end of the paddock (near the control tower). To enter the track, the grid marshal will need to see the run sticker displayed on your car and the correct wristband on your wrist. If you do not have these two items displayed, you will not be allowed to enter the track.

During NOLA Test & Tunes, we do not allow anyone to sit right seat – no coaches or ride-alongs.

The session is treated just like a practice session. Open passing anywhere. All driver safety gear must be worn when on track.

Please be advised that we will do Hot-Tows on the track. If we send the rescue vehicle out on track, we will display an EV flag (white flag with red cross in middle) at the starter stand and then follow the rescue vehicle around the course with the EV flag. If a car is in too dangerous a spot to tow out, we will bring everyone in to the paddock via black flag all.

As a reminder, this event is NOT associated with NASA or PCA. This event is held by NOLA Motorsports Park.

NOLA Motorsports Park carries four grades of fuel onsite – 87, 93, diesel, and 98. All fuel is ethanol-free. You pay at the pump with credit card only.

Announcements will be made over the PA system but you can also listen to announcements via the track FM station at 96.7.

If you are interested in reserved RV spots with power, please contact Scott Touchton at s.touchton@nolamotor.com. The cost for a spot with power is \$40/night.

If you are attending the NASA NOLA event this weekend, early registration is open on Friday from 3pm-6pm. Early tech also is open at the same time. Go through early NASA registration and tech if at all possible.
