

ANDERSON PUBLIC LIBRARY PETITIONS AND DISTRIBUTION OF LITERATURE POLICY

Anderson Public Library recognizes that the presentation of petitions and the distribution of literature by individuals and groups is a fundamental right protected by the First Amendment. However, the library also upholds the right of its customers and employees to enter and leave the library safely, without being impeded or unduly hindered. As a result, no petitioning or leafleting is allowed inside the library or on library property at any time.
