Location

The summer camp is located in building 951 in the Argonne Park Area, next to the child care center which is in building 952.

Registration

The program has spaces for 30 children each day with two camp counselors. Registration is on a first come first serve basis. To register your child you must submit registration form and pay the registration fee of \$75.00.*

Activities

Our summer camp program takes advantage of all that summer has to offer. Our program uses the surrounding communities and visitors to enhance your child's experience. Off-site field trips, on-site visitors and events occur throughout the summer.

Camp Counselors work with the children to develop areas of interest and expand on them to create week-long projects.

Scheduling

Families can choose a full time or part time schedule, or a combination of both.

Families are only required to use the program for the weeks that they need care. This allows families to schedule vacations without having to pay for the weeks of camp that they do not need. This advance scheduling allows the program to serve more families.

Each family is required to submit a list of weeks that they would like to use the program. Once we have made a commitment of attendance, families will pay for the weeks confirmed regardless of attendance.
