When tram line 51 at 3 March in its current form no longer runs, our constructor VITAL will start its work along the entire line from Westwijk up to and including the stop De Boelelaan/VU to renew the Amstelveen Line and turn it into a premium tram connection. That same date, 3 March, also marks the introduction of temporary public transport, including bus lines 55 and 551. In addition, there will be four weekends in March, April and June during which tram line 5 will not run.

There is no need to register. Just come in whenever it suits you best. Afterwards, we will make all information available at the 'Amstelveen InZicht' centre and on our website.
