## Nightwork tree felling Buitenveldertselaan

Dear residents, traders,

Early next year, work will commence in Buitenveldert for the renewal of the Amstelveen Line (tram 51). In order to create room for, amongst other things, building a new tram stop at A.J. Ernststraat, ten trees need to be felled, between the A.J. Ernststraat and De Boelelaan/VU stops. In addition, a new underground cable needs to be installed.

### Tree felling between 12 and 14 December

Our main contractor VITAL will do the tree felling in two stages. During the night from Wednesday 12 December into Thursday 13 December six trees will be removed at the east side of Buitenveldertselaan. During the night from Thursday 13 December into Friday 14 December four trees will be removed at the west side of Buitenveldertselaan. The ten trees which need to be felled are located between the tram tracks and Buitenveldertselaan. The work will take place during the night between 1.00 and 5.00 a.m., when the trams are not running and the overhead power line can be switched off.

### Inconvenience

The work will cause some inconvenience for road users. In the direction of Amsterdam, Buitenveldertselaan will be closed during the night of 12/13 December, and in the direction of Amstelveen during the night of 13/14 December. Cars, cyclists and pedestrians will be locally diverted and traffic wardens will be deployed. The work may also cause inconvenience in terms of noise and light, caused by tree sawing and works traffic. Furthermore, extra lighting will be needed to enable work during the night time.

**Installation new data cable 13-21 December**

For the new tram stop at A.J. Ernststraat a new data cable needs to be installed. This cable will cross the east side of Buitenveldertselaan at Asingaborg and will be connected to the existing cable by drilling underneath Buitenveldertselaan. The necessary work will begin on Thursday 13 December, will probably be finished by Friday 21 December, and will be done between 7.00 and 16.00 hours. By drilling, instead of using an open excavation, the inconvenience for the surrounding area will be very limited.
