This month we will cover animal habitats. Our first week we will learn about animals that live in

the desert. For art we will make desert dough using shaving cream and sand. We will also make our very own camel using our handprints. For math we will practice counting using cactus cuts out and counting splitters.

During our second week we will focus on the rainforest and the jungle. We will learn



about monkeys, snakes and toucans. For art we will be making monkeys, rain sticks and paper plate snakes. We will also make our very own jungle slime using liquid starch, glitter, watercolors and glue.



Our third week we will focus on animals that live in cold climates. We will be talking about Hibernation and Migration. We will also be learning about Polar Bears, Penguins and Walrus. We

will do an experiment to learn how animals who live in cold environments stay warm. During centers we will make a chart about everything we have learned about animals who live in cold temperatures.
