Our monthly theme for June is When I Grow Up. The kiddos will learn about community helpers/occupations, Father's Day/fishing/camping, transportation and construction.

For the first week of June, the kiddos will learn about different community helpers such as teachers, firefighters, police officers, astronauts, and veterinarians. The kiddos will practice what to do in case of a fire, pretend helping animals and people with the vet and doctor kit! The kiddos will also play pretend with the dress up clothes.

The second week of June, we will learn all about Father's Day and make special presents for dads and grandpas. We will also learn about camping and fishing. The kiddos will fish for letters in a water sensory table, as well as, make their own s'mores to eat! The kiddos will get to build tents using popsicle sticks and marshmallows. They will also go fishing for sea creatures using magnetic fishing poles in the sensory bin.

During the third week, we will learn about the different modes of transportation. The kiddos will categorize land, air and sea vehicles. The kiddos will use watercolors to paint bicycles, paint buses using blocks, and make paper plate steering wheels for art! The kiddos will also practice tracing blend of the week vocabulary words, discuss similarities and differences between water, land, and air vehicles.

During the fourth week, the kiddos will learn about construction. They will learn how roads and buildings are made. They will learn about different vehicles at a construction site, as well as, make wrecking balls for art! They will pretend to be construction workers and fix things in the classroom with the tool kit and dress up toys.
