

LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RESOLUTION 17-03

(Adopted May 25, 2017)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL:

SECTION 1. (a) The Legislative Council desires to continue its membership in the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL). To this end, the Legislative Council authorizes the Executive Director of the Legislative Services Agency to pay not more than \$221,032 from funds appropriated under HEA 1001-2017 for this purpose in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018.

(b) The Legislative Council desires to continue its membership in the Council of State Governments (CSG) and acknowledges that the appropriation for this purpose in Fiscal Year 2017 was \$2,053 less than the amount invoiced for membership dues for Fiscal Year 2017. To this end, the Legislative Council authorizes the Executive Director of the Legislative Services Agency to pay:

(1) the sum of \$2,053 from funds appropriated under HEA 1001-2017 to the Legislative Council and Legislative Services Agency in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017, to pay the remainder of the dues owed for Fiscal Year 2017; and

(2) not more than \$183,061 from funds appropriated under HEA 1001-2017 for council of state governments annual dues in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018, to pay membership dues payable for Fiscal Year 2018.

(c) The Legislative Council desires to continue its membership in the National Conference of Insurance Legislators (NCOIL). To this end, the Legislative Council authorizes the Executive Director of the Legislative Services Agency to pay \$10,000 from funds appropriated under HEA 1001-2017 for this purpose in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018.

(d) The Legislative Council desires to continue its membership in the Education Commission of the States (ECS). To this end, the Legislative Council authorizes the Executive Director of the Legislative Services Agency to pay \$91,800 from funds appropriated under HEA 1001-2017 for this purpose in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018.
