- Please give staff your respect and cooperation.
- Clean up after yourself and your group.
- The possession, consumption, or use of any alcoholic beverage, illegal drugs, or tobacco products by any individual (youth or adult) is not allowed during this event.
- Please silence all electronics.
- During Mass – and one hour prior to Mass – there is no food consumption.
- Compliance with all stated and or posted rules is required.
- Group coordinators are responsible for their participants.
