






Getting there

By Air

The nearest international airport is Billund Airport. There is 95 km from Billund Airport. There are many international and domestic departures / arrivals daily.

Copenhagen Airport is Denmark's Biggest Airport and has many daily international and domestic departures / arrivals. Copenhagen Airport is 345 km. from Holstebro, and provides daily domestic flights to Billund Airport and Karup Airport. Karup Airport is only a domestic airport and is located 35 km. from Holstebro.

NOTE: Transportation to and from airport will be arranged upon request.

By Car

Only 2.5 hours drive from the German / Danish border, 4 hours drive from Copenhagen and 2.5 hour drive from Frederikshavn. Holstebro is located in central Jutland, and can be reached by highway and expressway.

By Bus

In the local area run buses to the city center and Gråkjær Arena.

NOTE: transportation to and from the arena will be provided for both competitors and spectators.

Passports and visas

You need a valid passport (or ID card for EU). Norwegian and Swiss citizens plus citizens with EU passports may freely enter Denmark. Others should arrange for a VISA with the nearest Danish embassy or Consulate.

Currency

Although part of the EU, Denmark has its own currency. The Danish Krone commonly called the "KR.". 100 øre is 1 KR. Notes are denominated in 50 kr, 100 kr, 200 kr, 500 kr and 1000 kr. Coins are available 50øre, 1 kr, 2 kr, 5 kr, 10 kr, 20 kr.

Credit/Debit Cards

Visa and MasterCard are the most widely accepted cards although Diners club and American Express are also often accepted at larger shops and restaurants.

Telephone

Phone Cards

There are a number of Telephone calling card options available which can be purchased from post offices and many newsagents in Denmark.

Mobile Phones

Denmark uses a GSM cellular phone system compatible with phones sold in the rest of the Europe. As international roaming charges will apply you are advised to obtain a list of charges from your network provider National code is +45

Customs

When arriving into Denmark from an EU country you can bring in an unlimited amount of most goods. For excise goods such as alcohol and tobacco, there are no restrictions. However you must meet the conditions below:

You transport the goods yourself.

The goods are for your own use or as a gift. If the person you give the goods to pays you in any way - including reimbursing you for any expenses or payment in kind - then it's not a gift and the goods may be seized.

The goods are duty and tax paid in the EU country

where they were acquired. Non EU visitors are urged to check the applicable allowances prior to entering Denmark.

The seminar held at the 10th Global Cup in Holstebro by Jon Wicks will qualify the competitor for participating in the tournament.

Tanto Dori rules Seniors and veterans (18-34 and 35+)

- 1. Max. 3 teams per country
- 2. First, one member of the team must attack with two techniques: One technique from number 1 to 5 and one technique from number 6 to 10
- 3. After the second attack, the defender must obtain the knife and change to attack: They must also do two attacks: One technique from number 1 to 5 and one technique from number 6 to 10. Each tech nique must be different to those executed by the first team member.
- 4. After member two's second attack, member one must regain the knife to end the demonstration.
- 5. There are 2 teams: AKA and AO. Team AKA will start. Flag system will be used.
- 6. In the second round, teams must perform separate techniques from 1 to 5 and 6 to 10 again.
- 7. They can repeat previous techniques in the Finals.

Tanto Dori rules cadets and juniors (14-17)

- 1. Must use a wooden tanto.
- 2. Max. 3 teams per country
- 3. In the first round, one member of the team must attack with one tech nique from number 1 to 5.
- 4. After the attack, the defender must obtain the knife and change to attack: They must also do one technique but from number 6 to 10.
- 5. After member two's attack, member one must regain the knife to end the demonstration.
- 6. In the second round, teams must perform separate techniques from 1 to 5 and 6 to 10 again.
- 7. Each technique must be different.
- 8. There are 2 teams: AKA and AO. Team AKA will start. Flag system will be used.
- 9. They can repeat previous techniques in the Finals.

1.	In Individual Kumite, each country can enroll a total of 5 competitors per category / weight / height. This tournament will be run according to the WKF rules of competition Kumite.
	This event is only open for WIKF members.
1.1	The application of rules will be the responsibility of the referees with interna- tional qualifications of the WKF or EKF.
1.2	Each country or delegation can enroll his own referees and judges, as long as they are properly certified by their respective national federations or by EKF/WKF.
2.	In Team Kumite, each country can enroll a total of 4 teams per country in different categories. <i>This event is only open to WIKF members.</i>
2.1	In the Cadet 12-13, Cadet 14-15 and Junior 16-17 categories the teams should consist of 3 main competitors + 1 alternate competitors. However, it's possible to participate in the competition with only 2 main competitors.
2.2	In Senior categories (18-34) the team must be composed of 3 main competi- tors + 2 alternate competitors.
3.	The competitors are only allowed to participate in their own age category in individulas but can compete in the age above in team events.
4.	In Individual Kata, each country can enroll a total of 5 competitors per cate- gory. The official rules of WIKF will be used with a digital score card. <i>This event is only open to WIKF members.</i>
4.1	In the 1 st round, the competitor must perform the obligatory kata defined in the list for the category.
4.2	In the 2 nd round the competitor must perform a kata of his/her choosing which must be different from the kata performed in the 1 st round. In the Cadet category (up to 9 years), Cadet (10-11 years)
	in the 2 nd round it is obligatory to choose only Pinan Katas. In Cadet catego- ry (12-13 years & 14-15 years) the competitors can choose, in the 2nd round, either a Pinan or Superior Kata. All other categories (Junior, Senior and Veter- an), in 2nd round this competitor must choose a superior Katas.

4.3 4.4	If there is a 3 rd round, the Cadet competitors can repeat the kata performed in the 1 st or 2 nd round, or perform a new kata. Junior, Senior and Veteran competitors, in case there is a 3 rd round, must perform a different (new) ka- ta from the one performed in the 1 st and 2 nd round. In case of a tie, in any category, the kata to break the tie must be different than the kata performed in the previous round, except in Cadet (up to 9 years), Cadet (10-11 years), Cadet (12-13) and Cadet (14-15) categories, where one of the previous Kata can be repeated.
5.	In Tanto-Dori competition, each country can enrol a total of 3 teams per country.
	This event is only open for WIKF members.
5.1	This is only for cadets/juniors, seniors and veterans/super veterans.
5.2	The team is composed of two members either male or female.
5.3	The first member of the team must perform two attack techniques: one from number 1 to 5 and one from number 6 to 10.
5.4	After the second attack the defender must retrieve the knife and then change the attack. He must also perform two techniques: one from number 1 to 5 and one from number 6 to 10.
5.5	After the second attack of member number two, member one must retrieve the knife, ending the performance.
5.6	There will be two teams: team AKA and team AO. Team AKA starts.
5.7	The flag system will be used.
6.	Each coach must be properly registered with WIKF and follow these proce- dures.
6.1	It is only allowed for 1 coach to be next to the tatami by category, fully dressed with sports garment of its country.
6.2	Each coach must wear, at all times, the official identification accreditation, in order to remain next to the Tatami.
6.3	Only 7 coaches per country are allowed in Kumite and Kata.
6.4	Only 2 coaches per country or delegation are allowed at the coach meeting.

7. All the competitors are obliged to present, during the delegation registration, passport and the WIKF passport. Non presentation of these documents will mean no participation in the event.

- 8. All the competitors of individual Kumite are obliged to present themselves to the weight in the category that they are registered in. At the registration we will tolerate a weight deviation of +/- 200 g.
- 9. Change of category on the day of registration, due to exceeding or being low the athlete's weight will be allowed at an extra fee of 350 kr. Changing from one weight category to another is only possible, (at no charge) when a properly justified report is prepared by the head representative of the country or delegation and handed to the organization committee before August 1st 2022.
- 11. The organising committee of the event has the responsibility of resolving any problems that may occur during the event in consultation with Sensei Jon Wicks.
- 12. Any protest must be charged at the end of a match. Use official the protest form which will be issued at registration. There is a fee of 1500 kr. per protest.
- 13. Each country must enrol at least 1 kumite referee for all 3 days, otherwise there will be a penalty of 500 euro. Each country may enrol several referees but for kata a referee must hold the grade of minimum 4th Dan in WIKF and be approved by Sensei Jon Wicks. Each country must inform the organiser a month in advance the names of their kata referees.
- 14. The organiser has the right to determine how many kumite referees are needed.
- 15. There will be video review in ALL finals.





Protection/Dress Code

It is mandatory for all competitors to wear a white gi with the proper WIKF badge on their left chest. The mandatory protection for each event will be as defined in the official competition rules. Gloves, leg and foot protection must be of red or blue colour. Mouth guards and chest guards are mandatory for female contestants. Groin guards are optional and mouth guards are mandatory for male contestants. Body protection (vest) will be mandatory for ALL competitors. Any one not complying with these regulations may be expelled.

A proper tracksuit showing their nationality will be mandatory for coaches in all finals.
