



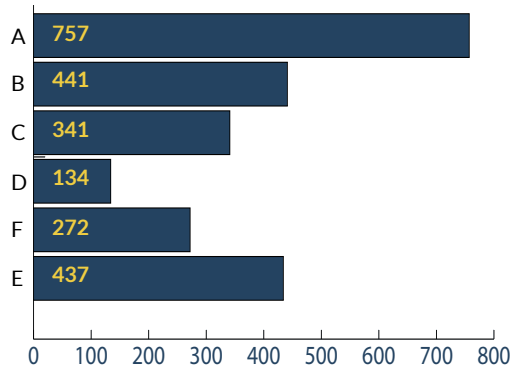

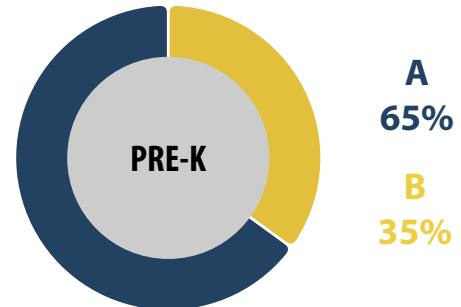
1. Which of the following changes would you support to increase road funding? (You may select more than one option.)

ROAD FUNDING:

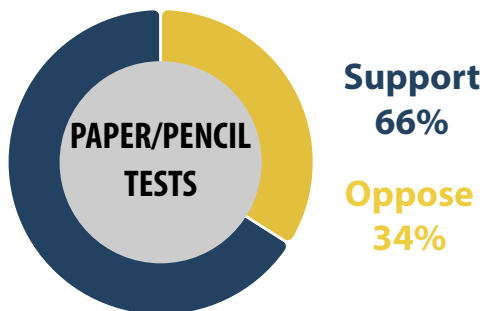
- A) Increasing the gas tax

- F) None of the above



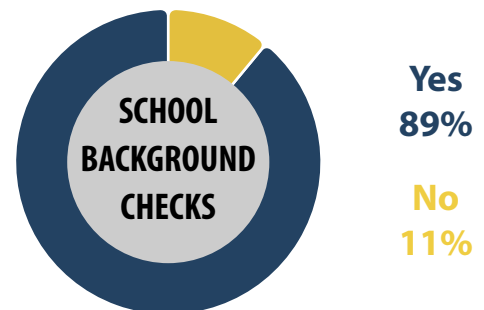
