Yellow Room

This was a busy month in the Yellow Room! Ms. Steffi used painters tape to create zig-zags and different shapes for the children to follow while creating block patterns. This activity encouraged mathematical thinking while also developing eye-hand coordinationa critical skill necessary for writing.

The children also explored many different forms of art, including a mess-free way to paint, which may be fun to try at home! Place a small piece of paper and paint in a zip-lock bag. Seal the bag and then tape it to a surface. Encourage your child to use their fingers to move the paint in all different directions.



Blue Room

This month in the Blue Room the children studied the artist Picasso! Through examining his art work, children were able to identify many different shapes, as well as develop an appreciation for cubism. They then had an opportunity to create their own Picasso-inspired masterpieces. Children really start to develop a deeper appreciation for art around this age, and it has been so fun watching them take pride in their work.

Ms. Melissa also created a game called "Letter Swat." The alphabet was hung in random order on the wall, and when Ms. Melissa would call out a letter, the children had to use the toy fly swatter to find and identify the letter. Using games for rote learning encourages children to remain engaged because they see the learning as fun. This activity also develops executive function, which supports brain plasticity!
