

ARVIND MANOCHA

Vice President & General Manager, Hollywood Bowl and Presentations

As Vice President and General Manager of the Hollywood Bowl and Presentations for the Los Angeles Philharmonic Association, Arvind Manocha oversees all operational, production, and construction-related activity with regard to the Hollywood Bowl, as well as the programming of jazz, world music, orchestral pops and pop/rock presentations by the Association at both the Hollywood Bowl and Walt Disney Concert Hall. Manocha manages the Association's relationships with its partners at the Bowl, including the Patina Group, and continues to foster the close partnership between the Bowl and the County of Los Angeles.

In 2000, Arvind Manocha joined the Los Angeles Philharmonic Association as the Director of Strategic Operations for Walt Disney Concert Hall, a position in which he oversaw the planning, coordination, and implementation of all initiatives related to the building and occupancy of Walt Disney Concert Hall by the Association. Previously, Manocha had been a strategy and business consultant, having worked in the Los Angeles offices of McKinsey and Co. He also worked for the Colburn Foundation, developing plans for both the Foundation as well as for the expanding Colburn School for the Performing Arts.

Born and raised in northeast Ohio, Manocha is a graduate of Cornell University and of the University of Cambridge in England (where he was a Marshall Scholar). Since 1998, he has been a board member of Pathways, a \$30 million child care resource and referral organization, and in 2001 was named its Vice President. In 2004, Manocha was named to the Advisory Board of the Los Angeles Forum for Architecture and Urban Design. In 2005 he joined the Board of Directors of the Colburn Foundation.
