Happy March Friends! This month we will learn about the Alphabet, Numbers, Colors and Fairy Tales!

For the first week of March, we will be focusing on learning about the alphabet! Children will make letters out of playdough and Duplo blocks, search for their name tags, and use our hands to make ice cream cones for our letter of the week, I. We will also be collaging, finger painting, and singing the Pirate ABCs.

During the second week we will learn all about numbers! We will be jumping on a hopscotch mat and counting the numbers, building towers using pool noodles and singing number rhymes. We will also be reading the number version of Chicka Chicka 123!

The third week of March will be focused on fairy tales and nursery rhymes. Children will practice their storytelling with the felt board, singing the Itsy Bitsy Spider in English and Spanish, and sorting peas made from green playdough. It's going to be a fun and busy week!

In the last week in March we will be learning about Colors! The teacher will ask each child what his/her favorite color is and sing the Colors songs. We will talk about the color wheel and how mixing colors can create new colors. We will be exploring shaving cream with the primary colors and exploring the new colors we make.
