In the first week of January, we will be learning about Polar animals and their habitat. We will be learning about polar bears, penguins, and hibernation. We will even try a cool experiment with blubber to explore how polar animals keep warm during freezing weather conditions!

In the second week of January, we will be talking about Rainforest/Jungle animal habitats. The daily themes will include snakes, chimpanzees, and even monkeys. The children will practice cutting this week with safety scissors.
