Rover Guard Hours

Wristbands required for reentry

No Spectators

- Must be participant, direct event support or crew member
- No other persons permitted unless direct family member. All persons must stay in their own paddock area at all times (or pit wall during session). No socializing, No wandering the PIR property to watch.
- ONE spotter per team may go to Chicane Grandstand only during relevant session

Participant Camping

- Thursday arrival So. Broadacre Field only. NO entry inside to PIR.
- Friday and Saturday overnight camping constrained to your paddock space. NO socializing. No shared spaces between participants.
- Be aware: Motocross Café and North Paddock Shop restrooms ONLY restrooms open overnight. Fast Track restrooms only open during the day.
- No alcohol allowed
- NO in and out after gates lock each night

Race Worker Camping

- Available starting Friday morning at 6:00 am
- Camp west of Motocross OR in Bradshaw acres
- Be aware: Motocross Café and North Paddock Shop restrooms ONLY restrooms open overnight. Fast Track restrooms only open during the day.
- Campers need to exercise social distancing of at least 10 feet apart between areas
- NO normally scheduled late day social event
- NO alcohol allowed
- NO close socializing. NO shared spaces between participants.
- NO in and out after gates lock each night
