

## 1956 Chevrolet Bel Air Station Wagon



This Chevy ran and drove well with some other issues of note. On the exterior I noted the wiper blades are not on the car. They are stored in the back of the car. I noted a scratch on the left rear door. There are minor misc scratches around the vehicle. Normal for mileage and most too small to see in photos. I noted some fish eyes in the paint around the roof at the drip rails. There is a chip in the paint on the tail gate. Poor rust repair in floors was noted. Viewing the floors from underneath I could see that the floors under the front and rear seats had rust repair and the repair was done crudely with pieces of sheet metal and not repaired using the correct patch panels for a 56 Chevrolet The right rear door will not open.

Inside I noted there is light wear to the seats. Normal for mileage. The odometer does not work. The rest of the aftermarket gauges functioned. The door panels and interior trim looked good overall. The windows worked. The aftermarket A/C worked well. I noted no smoke or odd odors inside.

Under the hood I noted full fluids.

I noted excessive back firing when accelerating. The owner stated that the back firing was caused by old gasoline, more diagnosis needed. Other than that, I found no issues on the test drive. The

transmission shifted as designed with no harsh engagement or slipping. The steering was responsive and the suspension was firm and the vehicle handled well. The brakes were firm with no pulsation felt. There were no leaks found to the underside of the vehicle.
