

## **Health Screenings at the JCCC**

- Effective September 1, 2021, health screenings for the childcare center will take place on the JCCC campus.
- Health screenings will take place in the carpool line for those remaining in their cars and in the vestibule of the
  center for those walking in to access the center. See the protocols for each below. Masks are required
  throughout the Health Screen process.
  - Carpool Parents Health Screen Protocol
    - 1. Remain in your car until a health screener approaches your vehicle.
    - 2. The health screener will review your health screen in the My Bright Day app and take your temperatures.
    - 3. Once you are cleared, a carpool escort will arrive at your vehicle to escort your child to their classroom.
  - Walk-in Parents Health Screen Protocol
    - 1. Maintain an appropriate distance while you await your health screen.
    - 2. Health screening will take place one family at a time in the vestibule.
    - 3. The health screener will review your health screen in the My Bright Day app and take your temperature.
    - 4. Once you are cleared, please limit your time in the center.
    - 5. We continue to serve an unvaccinated population and are dedicated to mitigating the risk of exposure for this vulnerable audience.

## **Parent Access Requests**

Effective September 1, 2021, custodial parents (parents, grandparents, legal guardian) may request access to the center for the following reasons:

- Drop-off and pick-up to and from their child's classroom
- Usage of the Mother's Room (see the protocol below)
  - Call the front desk in advance at 404-761-2323.
  - When you arrive at the center, stop at the front desk to check in.
  - o Staff will escort you to a vacant Mother's room where your child will be brought to you.

## **Parent Access Requirements**

In order to be granted access to the center, parents must meet all of the following criteria:

- Parents must wear a properly fitted mask.
- Parents must complete the health screen via the My Bright Day app.
- Parents must pass an on-site temperature check. Temperature checks will be completed in the center vestibule by a health screener, one family at a time.
- Parents must wash hands / use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
