Back to School!

We are looking forward to another great school year in the blue room. We are kicking it off with a lot of fun activities in the month of September. The first week we will be focusing on the season of fall. Students will explore various leaves and make leaf rubbings at art. We will also practice fine motor skills through sorting multicolored pom-poms to designated trees using tweezers.

The second week students will learn about apples and pumpkins. During this unit we will discuss the life cycles of both apples and pumpkins to discover how they grow. Students will have the opportunity to explore the parts of a pumpkin and taste test different types of apples.
