



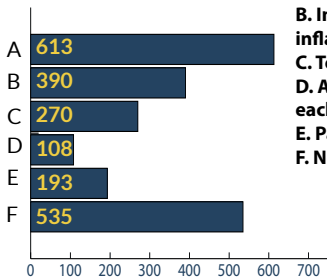

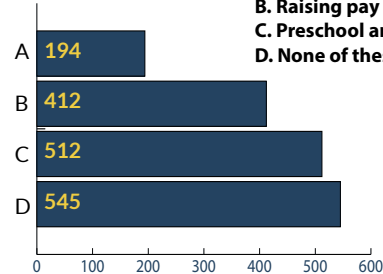
- A. Increasing the gas tax

- D. None of these need a funding increase



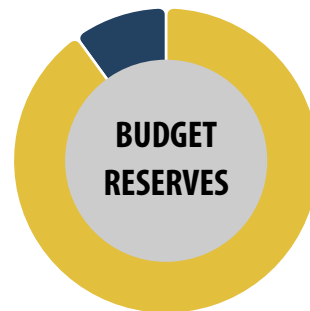

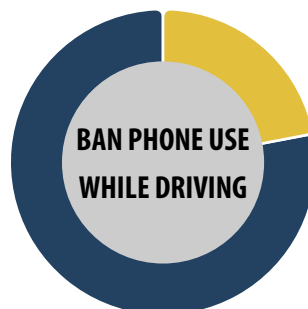
