From the Director

Although it seems like the distant past, I stepped into the position of Kelso Director last July for the final quarter of our fiscal year—and a good year it was.

I am pleased to present the San Antonio Museum of Art's first ever annual report. Due to our dedicated board and the leadership of my predecessor, Marion Oettinger, we continued to operate with a balanced budget. At the end of this report, you will see our financial statements, but there are other numbers I want to share, too.

100,000+ visitors

Last year, we attracted more than 100,000 visitors and a growing membership. Half of our annual attendance occurred on Free Tuesdays, which was generously supported by a grant from H-E-B and allowed us to reach a broader community. We believe that "If SAMA is open, they will come," and so to build on that success, we extended our hours on Friday and Saturday evenings until 9 pm. Keeping the doors open requires the dedication of many people. Seventy staff members, sixty volunteers, sixty-five docents and more than thirty interns worked hard to make the museum a thriving meeting place for our community.

25,000 works of art • 4 curators • 309 acquisitions

Our visitors came for our world-class collections. Four talented curators—John Johnston, Asian Art; Marion Oettinger, Latin American Art; Jessica Powers, Art of the Ancient Mediterranean; and David Rubin, Contemporary Art—offered an ambitious cross-section of exhibitions that highlighted the strengths of our collections.

We continued to expand our partnerships with other notable institutions for major shows, including *To Live Forever: Egyptian Treasures from the Brooklyn Museum* and *The Missing Piece*, a collaboration with the Committee of 100 for Tibet and the Dalai Lama Foundation. As part of SAMA's growing engagement with the San Antonio contemporary arts community, the museum participated in 2011 *Fotoseptiembre USA*, a citywide celebration of photography in contemporary art. Please turn to page four to read more about our exhibitions.

At the same time, we enriched our collections in fiscal 2011 with a wealth of new treasures—twenty-nine gifts comprising 309 works of art—showing the commitment and generosity of SAMA's patrons.

10,500+ students • 224 programs

Our education department coordinated more than 200 programs last year. Docents led 600 gallery talks and tours on everything from "Travel the Trade Routes" to "Science and Art Converge." With our diverse programming, we engaged more than 10,500 students from school districts across Texas. "SAMA on the Go" took art to students and schools outside the museum walls, often in underserved parts of our community. "First Sunday for Families" animated the museum with a rich variety of themed lectures, music and activities to appeal to families with children.

\$300,000+

Celebrating our thirtieth year, our annual Gala broke every fundraising record, netting more than \$300,000 through the deft leadership of Candace and Michael Humphreys. The museum won critical financial support through several large operating grants from the Brown Foundation, the Kronkosky Charitable Foundation and the Henry Luce Foundation, among others. SAMA also received \$330,000 in operating support from the City of San Antonio.

While we had many reasons to be joyful last year, we mourned the loss of dedicated and generous board members Hugh Half, Loretta Castle, and Nancy Hamon. We also mourned a loyal member of our staff, Matt Jones, who served the museum for more than fifteen years. He devoted his time to making the museum a better, safer and friendlier place.

When I arrived in July 2011, I set out to meet the mayor, the city manager and every city councilman. On my very first day, I met Councilman Diego Bernal on his first day in office. We shared our vision for District 1, which encompasses downtown San Antonio and SAMA, as the heart and soul of the arts in San Antonio. To that end, last year SAMA fostered partnerships with many of the city's cultural and civic organizations, including SA2020, the Office of Cultural Affairs, San Antonio River Authority, Broadway Reach, Downtown Alliance and the San Antonio Convention and Visitors Bureau, among others.

Our founders had enormous foresight and courage to buy a dilapidated brewery and fallow land on the river. Now the rest of San Antonio is catching up to our founders' vision. We have gone from being an isolated place on the fringe to being a destination at the heart of the city's cultural district, on a scenic new bend of the river's Museum Reach. Our zip code, 78215,



has become a blossoming place to live, work and play. Our goal is for SAMA to become an integral part of the cultural life of all San Antonians, an essential "third space" for community gathering that fosters social and creative interaction.

As SAMA enters its fourth decade, I am proud to be part of this institution and the community it serves. More than thirty years ago, the museum was christened by breaking a bottle of beer. In the coming years, with your support, we expect to create many occasions for Champagne!

October 16, 2010 through January 9, 2011

Visitors were invited to delve into the ruins of ancient Egypt with the exhibition *To Live Forever: Egyptian Treasures from the Brooklyn Museum*. The exhibition featured more than 100 works of art from the Brooklyn Museum that explored the Egyptians' beliefs regarding the afterlife and offered fresh insights into ways the Egyptians outside the royal family prepared for eternal life in the next world.

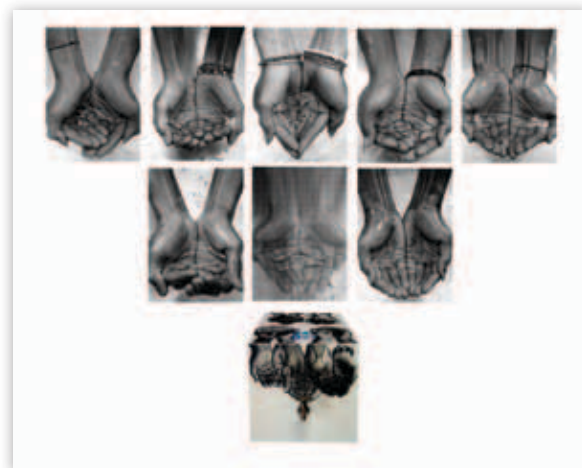

Animal Instinct: The Photographs of Daniel Lee

September 3, 2011 to February 19, 2012

Animal Instinct was a survey exhibition of Daniel Lee's photography from 1993 to 2010. Lee uses digital technology to create hybrids of human beings and animals, portraying the idea that people often exhibit behavioral, personality and physical traits that resemble those of animals. Since the early 1990s, Lee has examined human behavior as related to such themes as the Chinese horoscope, Buddhist ceremony, punk nightclubs, genetic altering, dreams and the circus.

Animal Instinct was presented in conjunction with *Fotoseptiembre USA* and was made possible with support from Jerry Gore, the City of San Antonio Office of Cultural Affairs, Taipei Cultural Center and Texas Commission on the Arts.

Paul Jacoulet: Views of Korea

August 12, 2011 through November 6, 2011

Paul Jacoulet (1902-1960) was the first foreigner to master printmaking in the Japanese tradition. The artist was born in France but spent most of his life in Japan. Two sets of eight Jacoulet prints depicting Korea comprised the two rotations in the Asian Art Special Exhibitions Gallery.

Shibata Zeshin (1807–1891) married traditional techniques with his own set of complex skills, deep knowledge and innovation to create a collection of lacquer work and painting admired for its creativity, excellence in technique and beauty. Thomas and Catherine Edson’s broad survey of Zeshin objects has made quite the journey since its inception as a fifty-three piece exhibition organized by San Antonio Museum of Art and curated by Dr. Sebastian Izzard and Ms. Martha Blackwelder. *The Genius of Shibata Zeshin: Japanese Masterworks from the Catherine and Thomas Edson Collection* premiered at San Antonio Museum of Art February 17 – May 6, 2007 and then traveled to Minneapolis Institute of Arts, Minneapolis, MN, October 14, 2007 – January 6, 2008. Organized by San Antonio Museum of Art and Japan Society, New York, NY, and curated by Joe Earle, Vice President, Japan Society, Director, Japan Society Gallery, *The Genius of Japanese Lacquer: Masterworks by Shibata Zeshin*, March 21 – June 15, 2008 featured not only the Edson Collection but twenty-four additional works showcasing one of the most comprehensive Zeshin exhibits seen in the United States in the last hundred years. Continued success of the Edson’s Zeshin Collection prompted Nikkei, Inc., Japan to organize *Edo Chic/Meiji Technique: The Art of Shibata Zeshin featuring the Edson Collection*;

an exhibit including seventy-one works by Shibata Zeshin toured Japan with stops at Mitsui Memorial Museum, Tokyo, December 5, 2009 – February 7, 2010, Jotenkaku Museum of Shokoku Temple, Kyoto, April 3 – June 6, 2010, and Suiboku Museum, Toyama, June 25 – August 22, 2010. After a short rest, the Genius of Shibata Zeshin will once again be on view at the Musée Cernuschi, Paris, France, April 6 – July 15, 2012 in an exhibit entitled *Rêves de laque, le Japon de Shibata Zeshin, avec la collaboration de la Collection Catherine et Thomas Edson, San Antonio Museum of Art*, inviting a whole new audience into the masterful world of Shibata Zeshin.

Education and Outreach

Adult and Public Programs

The San Antonio Museum of Art believes that we have the responsibility to educate and engage diverse audiences, provide transformational experiences, strengthen our shared understanding of humanity and encourage a sense of wonder and discovery. To that end, the museum focuses on providing programs for adult, family, youth, school and community audiences.

Offered throughout the year at SAMA, concerts are scheduled to enhance learning and public interest in SAMA's permanent collections and special exhibitions. This year *Music on the Move* took audience members on an innovative musical tour through the Contemporary Art galleries. Gallery concerts given by local ensembles took place in the Spanish Colonial and Roman Art galleries. Also in the galleries, visitors learned introductory meditation techniques with the primary goal of relaxation by participating in Meditation in the Japanese Gallery on Saturday mornings throughout the year.

David S. Rubin, The Brown Foundation Curator of Contemporary Art, engaged artists Adam Fuss and Susan Plum, featured in *The Missing Peace* exhibition, Daniel Lee, featured in *Animal Instinct*, as well as Gary Sweeny and Trish Simonite, featured in SAMA's permanent collection, in discussions about their work in the Conversations with Contemporary Artists series.

SAMA offered a host of lectures throughout the year related to both special exhibitions, such as *To Live Forever*, *Moctezuma's Table*, and *The Missing Peace*, as well as to the permanent collections. The museum is fortunate to receive support for lectures from membership groups that support collections. For instance, the lecture "Sacred Sites of Burma" was supported by Friends of Asian Art, and "Soundways and Architectural Space: The Byzantines as Builders, Singers and Listeners" was supported by Friends of Ancient Art. Additionally, ongoing support through endowments from Bank of America Foundation, Gloria Galt, Louis A. and Frances B. Wagner, Mary Kargl, and NEH allow SAMA to present several diverse and enriching lec-

tures annually from some of the world's most renowned experts in every aspect of the arts. Dr. Wallace-Hadrill of Cambridge presented "Herculaneum: Living with Catastrophe" as part of the Mary Kargl Lecture Series.

SAMA's Free Tuesday programming includes several weekly and monthly learning opportunities. The weekly Sketching in the Galleries program offers an evening of casual instruction based on the paintings and sculptures found in the museum's collections. On the first Tuesday of each month SAMA's curators give insightful twenty-five minute talks about works of art on display for the Curator's Choice Gallery Talks series. Docent guided tours of SAMA exhibitions and permanent collections are scheduled regularly throughout the month and are available to the public for free with museum admission. Writers Respond to Art, made possible by the M.E. Hart Foundation, featured original responses to objects in the Latin American Art collection by local writers in collaboration with Gemini Ink.

Throughout the year, SAMA's cinema program featured both classic and contemporary films and film series that focused on topics relating to permanent collections or special exhibitions at the museum, often enriched by perspectives from authors, critics, curators and scholars. This year, the SAMA Screens film series was presented by Fidelity Investments San Antonio and the Friends of Asian Art supported SAMA's Celebration of Cambodian Royal Films.

Family Programs

Children and families are invited to explore the collections, create art and share Sundays with the family. *First Sundays for Families* are free for children 12 and under and free for members. Throughout the year, topics ranged from "A World of Color" to "SAMA Celebrates the Year of the Rabbit" and "Hail Caesar! Greek and Roman Family Day." This program was made possible by generous support from Alturas Foundation, Bank of America Charitable Foundation, Faye L. and William L. Cowden Charitable Foundation, M.E. Hart Foundation, San Antonio Area Foundation, and the San Antonio Museum of Art docents.

For the first time, SAMA opened its doors for Night At The Museum, a "kids-only" party. Throughout the night, kids participated in activities ranging from a flashlight tour of the *To Live Forever* exhibition, to "mummy-wrapping" and a scavenger hunt.

"What's in Your Museum?," SAMA's Summer Youth Program, incorporated a variety of activities to include gallery talks and tours, hands-on demonstrations from local artists and museum educators, painting, drawing and sculpture activities, storytelling, creative writing and more. "Stories and Myths Around the World," "Discover the Ancient World," "Passport to Asia," and "Journey through Latin America" were the themes explored in these four week-long summer camps based on the permanent collection. Scholarships provided by the San Antonio Museum of Art docents were used to pay the way for students nominated by teachers in area school districts.

Educator and School Programs

Teachers attending K-12 Teacher Workshops earned Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credits and learned how to connect SAMA collections and exhibitions to classroom curricula through thematic school tours, student workshops, and lesson plans. These programs were made possible by generous support by USAA Charitable Foundation and JP Morgan Chase Foundation.

SAMA's trained docents provided tours and hands-on workshops for school groups designed to meet school curriculum needs. Financial assistance to cover admission fees and bus transportation expenses for K-12 school groups was made available by the Valero Energy Foundation.

Community Outreach

For the third year in a row, the San Antonio Museum of Art and Good Samaritan Community Services worked collaboratively to provide underserved elementary and middle school students with visual arts classes on the campuses of both institutions throughout the school year. The students participating in SAMAlliance come from Edgewood Independent School District and the San Antonio Independent School District. Due to the increased volume of student participation, the program has grown from one to two classes per week. SAMAlliance ended with an exhibition of works by the students in the Great Hall of the museum. This program is made possible by generous support from the M.E. Hart Foundation.

Through SAMA on the Go, a program that offers offsite, hands-on art experiences with local schools, the museum served the community with creative and stimulating curriculum to enhance the appreciation of art. This program is free of charge to classrooms within San Antonio. At the end of the program, participating students receive a family pass that provides free admission to the San Antonio Museum of Art for everyone in the family.

K-12 teachers and their students traveled around the world while using SAMA's Traveling Trunks. 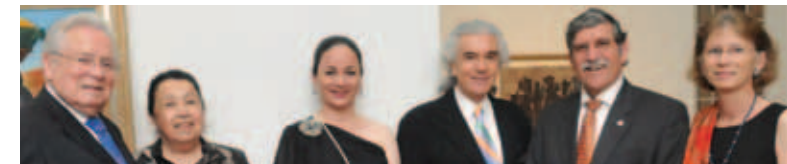
