



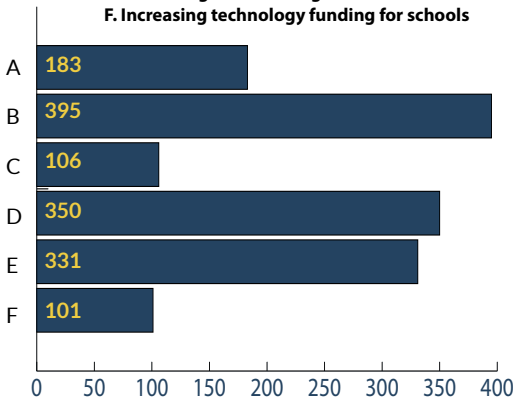

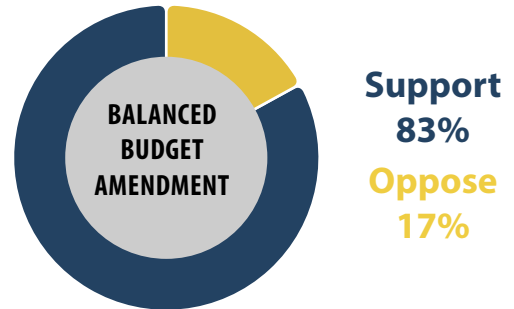
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2017 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F. Increasing technology funding for schools



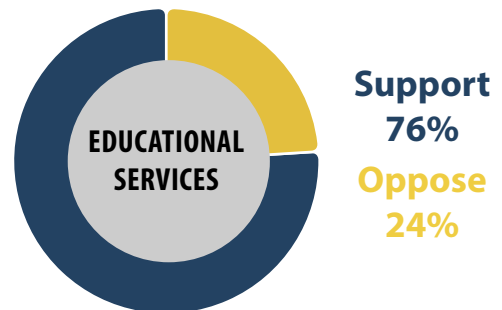
2. Do you support or oppose amending the Indiana Constitution to require the General Assembly to pass a balanced budget?

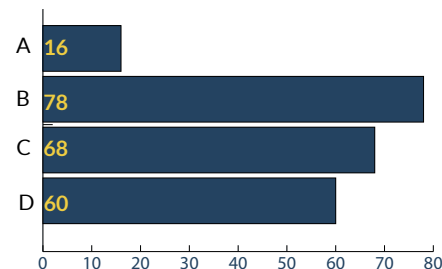

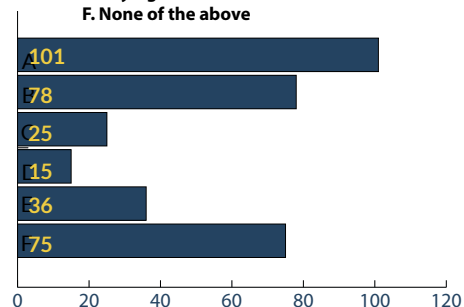

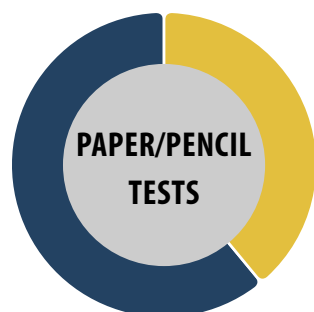
8. Which of the following do you think is more important?

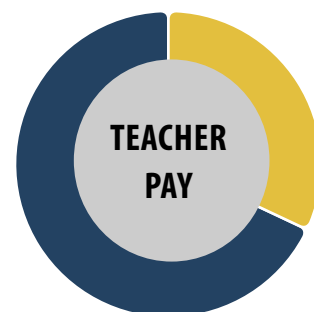

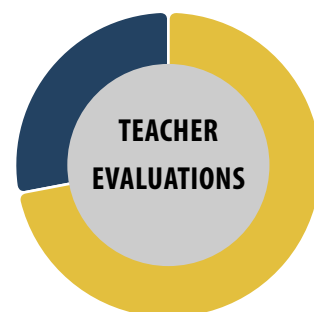
9. The U.S. is facing a shortage of teachers in subjects like math, science and special education. Do you think that Indiana should direct more school funding specifically to teacher pay?

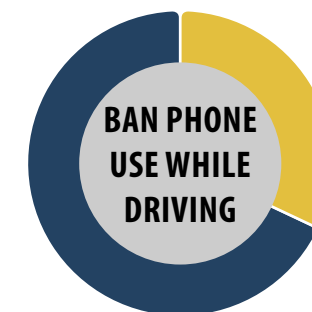
12. Do you support or oppose allowing the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?
