



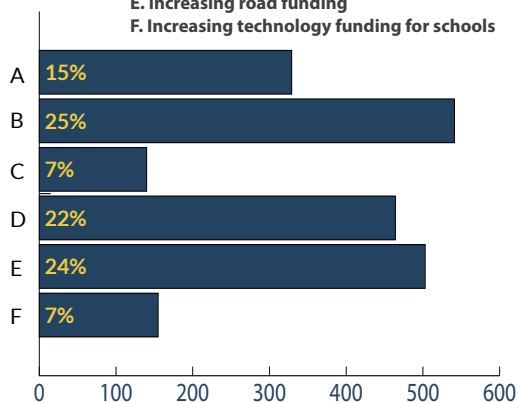

### BUDGET PRIORITIES

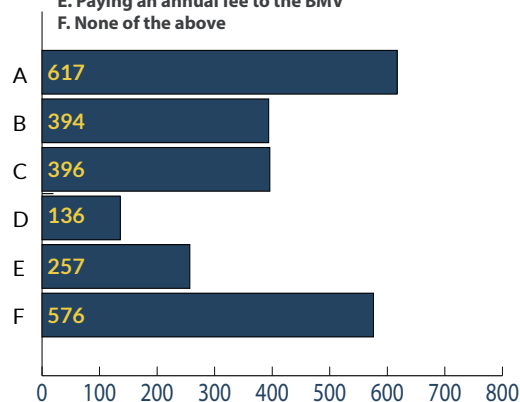

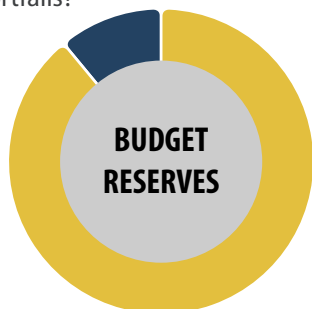
2. Which of the following changes would you support to increase road funding? (You may select more than one option.)

- F. None of the above



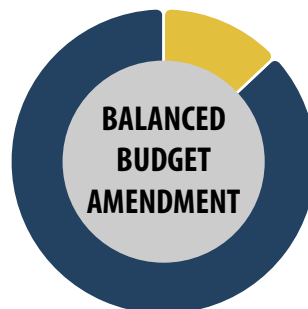

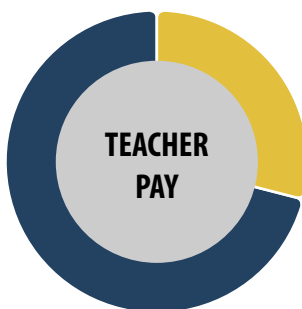
4. Do you support or oppose amending the Indiana Constitution to require the General Assembly to pass a balanced budget?
