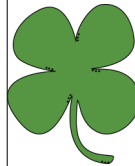

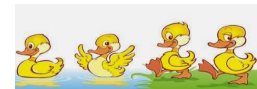


During week three we will be welcoming Spring! We will talk about all the weather changes we see and what kind of flowers blossom. Children will
