Happy March Friends!
This month we will learn about STEM, Spring and Weather, and Wetlands and Ponds. We will also be celebrating St. Patrick's Day too!

The first week our students will learn about the weather and the Spring season through science experiments, writing sight and CVC words, playing fun math games, and make weather art!

The second week we will explore science, technology, engineering, and math (S.T.E.M.) through "hands on" activities. The kiddos will make alphabet sky scrappers using Legos, write their names with shapes, and dive into ice with magnets and other materials. The children will also use unique and different materials to create art.

The third week we

will be talking about St. Patrick's Day and the country Ireland. The kiddos will learn facts about Ireland such as what kind of music they dance to, what some famous landmarks look like, and as a group, we will make corn beef hash!

During week four, the children will jump into ponds and wetlands all over the world. They will learn the life-cycle of frogs, measure various animals, and learn about the wetland animals through rhyming and writing.
