In the first week of
January, we will be talking all
about the polar habitat!
Children will be learning all
about which animals hibernate
and which ones don't. Children
will also be working on addition
and subtraction by using
penguins to help them solve
the equation. Children will be
making a polar bear in a snow
globe, a cotton tummy
penguin, walrus head and so
much more!
