4. Top tips

- Stay and work in the UK with the Graduate Route, visit https://www.gov.uk/graduate-visa to find out more
- Universities will make admission decisions based on predicted grades, or final grades if you have completed your school education. Typical offers will be conditional on the final grades
- Apply by 15 October for courses at the Universities of Oxford and ٠ Cambridge, or for courses in medicine, veterinary medicine/science and dentistry
- Apply by the last Wednesday in January for most undergraduate courses and for your application to be guaranteed consideration
- 30 June is the late deadline for most undergraduate courses Applications received after this deadline will automatically go into 'clearing'
- UCAS Clearing is a system that matches university applicants who haven't had an offer with institutions that still have places available

3. Getting ready to arrive

Meet the conditions of your offer and have your place confirmed by the university Check if you need a student visa at https://www.gov.uk/student-visa Obtain your Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) number and apply for your visa As part of the visa, there is an Immigration Health Surcharge which entitles you to free NHS treatment

Arrange travel – UKVI recommend not booking travel until you've received your visa Check university arrival information and Freshers (Orientation) Week details Pack your luggage and get excited
