We are starting the month off by learning all about robots and inventions! Children will be painting with gear builders and using their creativity to make their own robots during art, participating in a large group activity to learn about the invention of the telephone, and at the literacy table the kiddos will identify and trace letters on paper robots.

Ahoy Matey - we are learning about pirates this week! We will walk the plank while counting out ten steps, test objects to see whether they sink or float, read pirate themed books, play a letter coin matching game, make a parrot out of a toilet paper tube, and create a telescope.

This week, the children will turn into paleontologists as we learn about dinosaurs! Our class will learn how to identify dinosaurs by their proper name, practice tracing different types of lines, explore sand and dinosaur bones in the sensory table, and even create their own dinosaur fossils during art.

During the last week of August, the kiddos will be exploring the Wild West! We will be creating our very own banjos and popsicle cacti at the art table, playing western themed BINGO during the literacy center as well as measuring cacti and using large lacers as lassos to practice counting to ten in Spanish as we lace on some wooden rings.
