2. Eligibility

To be eligible for participation in the 6th Asian Championship, a competitor must comply with the Ju Jitsu Asian Union (JJAU).

Only nationals of the country of the JJNO shall be qualified to represent the JJNO in the championship.

JJNOs that withdraw their athletes after the submission of the final entries by name Draw, will not be allowed to replace the athlete.





3. Competition Information

Competition Dates : March 28th, 29th, 30th & 31th

Competition Venue : Bahrain National Stadium

Arrival: March 25-26th

4. Events

The Ju-Jitsu competition will consist of Fourteen (14) events containing seven (7) categories for men, and seven (7) category for women in three (3) disciplines, plus six (6) events in DUO discipline (three in classic and three in show).

Open to ALL ASIAN National Members.

Two athletes/teams per category per nation

- Duo-Classic System: Women; Men; Mixed
- Show-System: Women; Men; Mixed
- JJIF Jiu-Jitsu (Ne-Waza)
- JJIF Fighting
- Ju-Jitsu Contact

CATEGORIES MUST HAVE MINIMUM OF 3 DIFFERENT NATIONS REGISTERED TO RUN

Weight category as follows

ADULT MALE: -56 -62 -69 -77 -85 -94 +94 Kg

ADULT FEMALE: -45 -48 -52 -57 -63 -70 +70 Kg

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8. Doping Control

Asian Championship organizer committee (ACOC), under the guidance of the International Testing Agency (ITA), will be responsible for the Anti-Doping Programme during the 6th Asian Championship, 2022.

All members should make their competitors aware that there will be doping control for several athletes. An athlete identified for doping testing should be accompanied by a team official for the entire testing process.

If you have entered the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medication contains any substances on WADA's Prohibited List:

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

Competition Rules

The Ju-Jitsu competition of the 6th edition of the Asian Championship will be held in accordance with the Ju-Jitsu International Federation (JJIF) Competition Rules and relevant Rules and Regulations, in force during the tournament time.

In case of any disagreement in the language interpretation of the rules and regulation, the English version shall prevail. Any unforeseen case not covered by the regulations and rules shall be resolved in accordance with the JJIF Rules and Regulations.

Competition Format

In the Ju-Jitsu competition, each weight category will consist of a double elimination repechage tournament. The winners of the Semi-finals will advance to the Final. The competitors defeated in the elimination rounds will compete in the repechage, the two winners of repechage contests will be ranked third places.

Competition organized by bracket with all participants getting a second chance

Brackets format:

Best of Three Matches (divisions with 2 players)

3 Players - Comeback (divisions with 3 players)

Round-Robin (divisions with 4 - 5 players)





Combined Pool - Round Robin + Final Bracket (divisions with 6 players)
Double-Elimination Brackets (divisions with 7 or more players)

11. Draw

JJIF Competition Rules, Organization and Sporting Code of JJIF. We make an appeal to all participants to respect fair-play and JJIF Book of Ethics! (actual competition rules are provided also on the official web site of JJIF www.jjif.sport).

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Computer program, approved by JJIF;

Draw will be made remote by JJAU Sport Director and responsible officials together with the IT specialist;

The draw will be done after registrations are confirmed for all competition days and it is final!

After publication of first draw coaches have 30min to control and indicate mistakes. Final brackets will be issued after correction period.

If a competitor will not have the correct weight at weighing – or the birth dates are not correct - he/she will stay in a pool/table but will automatically lose the match no change will be made to the draw and no refund because of not fulfilling conditions for participation when already registered.

General mistakes discovered at the draw can be corrected by JJIF officials (such as wrong name, persons with similar names put in wrong categories etc.

12. Weigh in

Weigh In shall be conducted in the Venue, under the control and supervision of the Sports Director and officials appointed by him.

Official Weigh in for each category shall be completed on the previous day of the relevant contest, according to the competition schedule.

Each competitor shall bring their accreditation card. No tolerance shall be allowed above the weight category.

Unofficial weigh in on the official scales will be available for those competing on the day before from 30 minutes before the official weigh in.

Athletes competing in different disciplines have to weight in for each competition day separately. (additional weight in hours may be provided for athletes competing during official weight in).

13. Training Arrangement

Training Requirement Form will be provided by the competition management when delegations arrive at Athletes hotel. All teams must submit the training requirement forms to book a training session before 17:00 prior to the day of the training



session, though the Sport Information Center in the Athlete hotels. Each team may book 60 minutes training session per day.

14. Uniform / Gi

All competitors must have and use WHITE GI according to the JJIF rules and belts in proper colour (Red and Blue) for official competitions.

Participants must bring their GI to registration in order to have the competition logo showed on, (GI with other back number are not allowed).

All competitors must bring their own red and blue belts. The GI must be clean.

15. Referees

JJAFU will invite qualified referees for the championship. Participation in the refreshment is obligatory.

Before start the competition day, all referee will meet at Arena on 8:30 to receive uniform, radios and the last instructions about the championship.

16. Health Protocol

The Ju-Jitsu competition of the 6th edition of the Asian Championship will be held in accordance with the special protocol approved by the Bahrain Health Authority.

All delegations MUST follow it. Any NF member who disrespect the guidelines will be automatic disqualified of the event, and will be under the Bahrain health protocol for visitors automatically.

- PCR at the airport
- PCR on the weigh in
- PCR after the competition finish so they can travel back

Guidelines for the participating National Federations

Hotel must be booked with JJAU Organizing Committee;

Flight details must be informed to the OC

Visas will be applied by OC together with Bahrain government;

Once approved, the NF will receive the members visas and hotel bookings;

On arrival at BAHRAIN airport, the delegation will be guided by members of the organization due the special protocol. Anyone who get in the country by their own ways, will face the regular protocols adopted in BAHRAIN;

Special transportation will be designed from airport to the delegation hotel;

In the hotels, there will be volunteers guiding all participants and everyone will be test for COVID;

No one can leave their rooms until the OC receive the first test results;

Special transport will be available from hotel to venue and venue to hotel;





On the last day, the delegations will be moved from hotel to airport by the designated transport;

Important: no tourist or socializing activities will be allowed during the event.
Once again: any participant who leave the "bubble" will be severely penalized.

The health Protocol can and will be adapted to the actual situation and regulations and can change any time!!
