



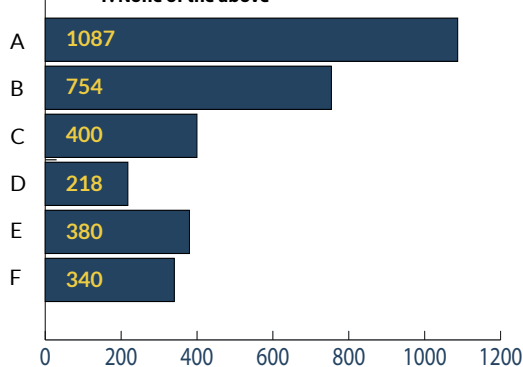

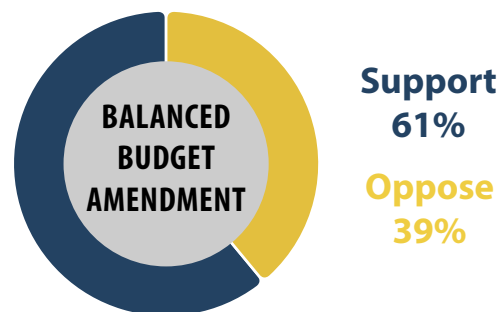
1. Which of the following changes would you support to increase road funding? (You may select more than one option.)

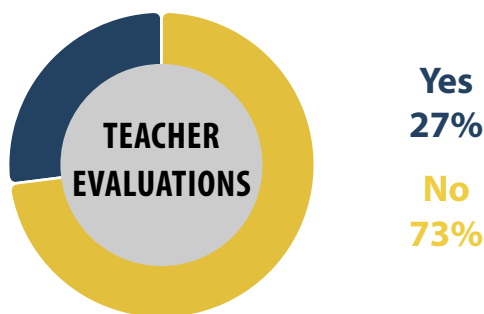

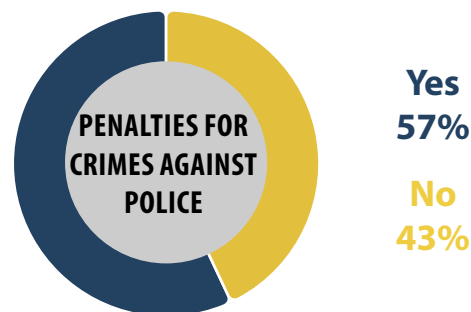
2. Do you support or oppose amending the Indiana Constitution to require the General Assembly to pass a balanced budget?

5. Should the Indiana Constitution be amended to establish an appointed commission to draw state legislative and congressional district boundaries?



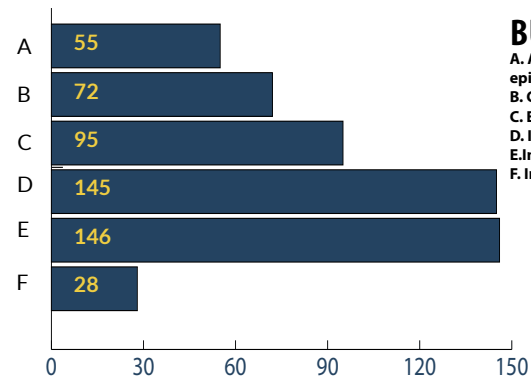

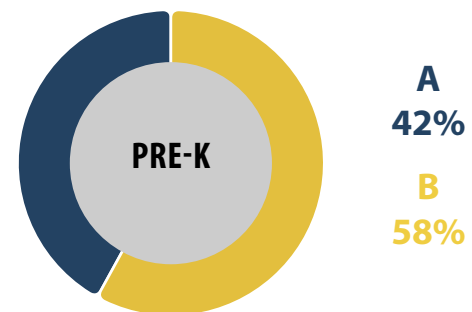
6. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2017 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?



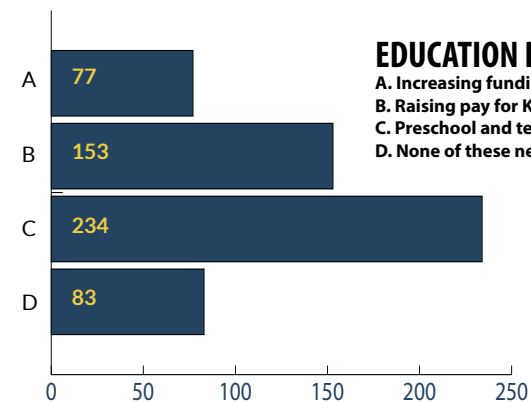

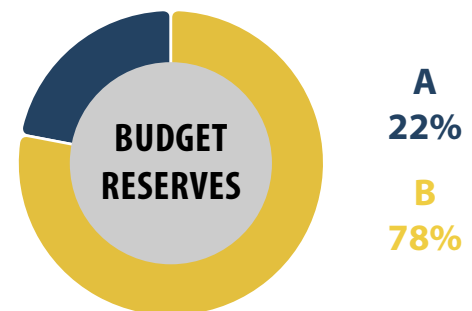
8. Which of the following do you think is more important?



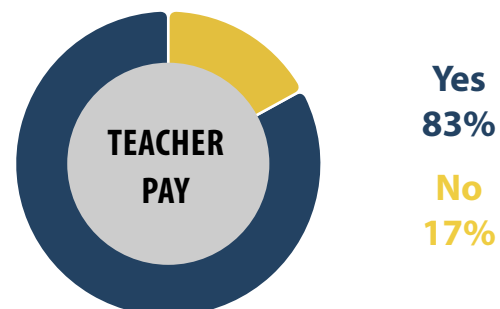

10. The U.S. is facing a shortage of teachers in subjects like math, science and special education. Do you think Indiana should direct more school funding specifically to teacher pay?



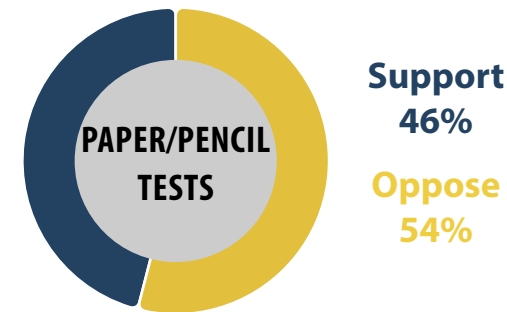

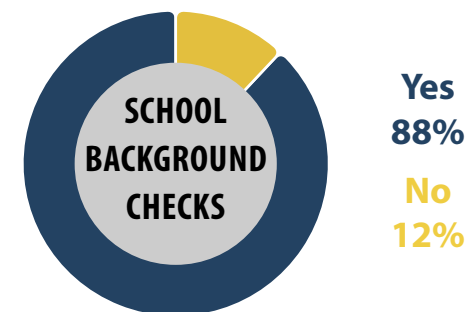

13. Do you support or oppose giving parents of children with special needs the option to use state educational funding for services such as school choice, tutoring or online courses?



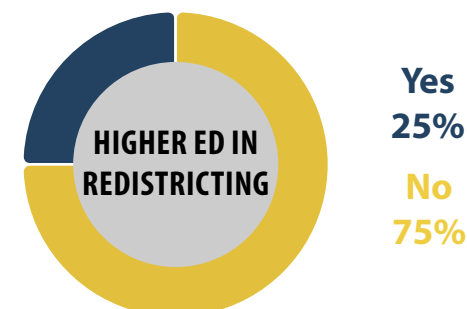
14. Do you think school employees who work with children should be required to pass criminal background checks every 5 years?

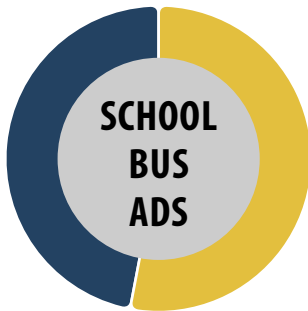
