We hope you enjoyed the month of May and we have many wonderful activities planned for June! We would also like to welcome our new friends from Blue Room- Luca, Lia, Mila, Jezzah, Christopher and Sydney. We are so proud of your transition and can't wait to learn and grow together!

During the first week of June we will be learning about Father's Day, camping, and fishing. Topics include campfires, nature and how to make fun treats like S'mores! During science, students will be going on a nature hunt. During literacy students will be completing posters about their dads. During art, students will be making popsicle-stick tents and students will be painting with nature inspired paint brushes.

During the second week, we will be learning about occupations and community helpers. Topics include teachers, firefighters, police officers, doctors, and chefs. During literacy, students will write a ticket for a pretend crime and draw a picture. During math, students will add rungs (brown pipe cleaners) to the fire truck's ladder each time they roll the numbered cube. During art, students will use q-tips to make an x-ray of them on black paper.

During the third week of the month students will be learning about transportation. Topics include cars, trains, boats, scooters and airplanes. During literacy, students will be writing a journal prompt asking what their favorite way to transport is as well as coloring a picture. During science students will be learning about items that sink and those that float. During art students will be making cool name trains!

During the last week of the month, students will be learning about construction. Topics include construction workers, bulldozers, excavators, dump trucks, and rollers. During literacy, students will help the bulldozer get to the construction site by writing the missing alphabet letters. During math, students will use linking cubes to measure how long construction tools are. During art, students will use paint to color a premade dump truck using egg cartons. We look forward to learning and growing throughout the month of June!
