7. Announce the First Mystery (which may be followed by a brief reading of Scripture); then say the *Our Father*.

8. While holding each of the ten beads, say a *Hail Mary*, while meditating on the First Mystery.

9. Say the *Glory Be* on the last bead.

10. Say the Fatima Prayer.

11. Announce the Second Mystery (which may be followed by a brief reading of Scripture); then say the *Our Father*.

12. While holding each of the ten beads, say a *Hail Mary*, while meditating on the Second Mystery.

13. Say the Glory Be on the last bead.

14. Say the Fatima Prayer.

15. Announce the Third Mystery (which may be followed by a brief reading of Scripture); then say the *Our Father*.

16. While holding each of the ten beads, say a *Hail Mary*, while meditating on the Third Mystery.

23. Announce the Fifth Mystery (which may be followed by a brief reading of Scripture); then say the *Our Father*.

24. While holding each of the ten beads, say a *Hail Mary*, while meditating on the Fifth Mystery.

25. Say the Glory Be on the last bead.

26. Say the Fatima Prayer.

27. Say the Hail, Holy Queen (Salve Regina).

28. Say the closing prayer:

V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God,

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

V. Let us pray:

O God, whose Only Begotten Son, by his life, Death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that, while meditating on these mysteries of the most holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

29. Conclude with the Sign of the Cross.
