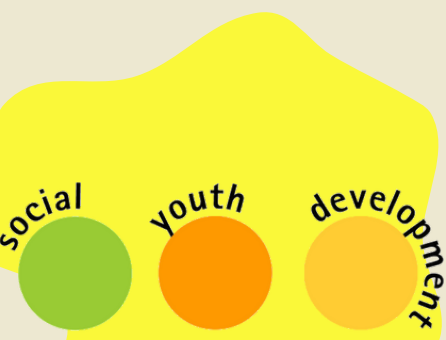

Dog Rescue Centre

In the Dog Rescue Centre abandoned and stray dogs are taken off the streets, cared for and given the chance to find a new home. The local youth is participating actively in the society. The role of the volunteer will be, in collaboration with rest of the projects that k.a.ne is leading or cooperating , to spread information, create new content & inspire young people



VOLUNTEER TASKS

- Assisting with the daily running of the animal shelter.
- Cleaning the shelter and looking after the facilities.
- Feeding the dogs and taking responsibility for their hygiene.
- Taking the dogs for a walk.
- Preparing the dogs for adoption.
- Participating in the programming, development and evaluation of activities of the coordinating organisation (K.A.NE.).

K.A.NE OFFICE

This project involves working directly with K.A.NE.in our office and helping with our core activities. K.A.NE. as a social youth development organisation coordinates youth mobility projects, seminars and trainings, youth exchanges, conferences, school visits and educational events.



VOLUNTEER TASKS

- Assisting with administrative tasks and the daily running of K.A.NE.'s office.
- Preparing for and helping with external activities (school visits, info-days and other cultural and educational activities in the city).
- Participation in the programming, development and evaluation of K.A.NE.'s activities.
- Researching and developing informative resources. Coordinating an "info point" in order to provide information about opportunities abroad for local young people.
- Developing other projects on social, environmental and cultural issues.

Youth Center Co-lab

Youth Centre of Kalamata: A space created by young people for young people. A space for creation, culture, art and intercultural dialogue. The activities of the Youth Centre are based on voluntary work, skills exchange, peer education, learning by doing and non-formal learning. Youth are part of a place that offers opportunities in social life. professional and educational level and language support for those who cannot afford paying in private language institutions.

From its beginning it was, and still is, an initiative of young people aiming to create an open space for helping youth to understand and use their creativity in order to discover new tools for expression and participation in social life.

VOLUNTEER TASKS

- Taking care of the Youth Centre and its activities. Participation in the programming, development and evaluation of the activities.
- Preparation of the material; searching, finding and developing the informational resources.
- Preparation and running the “info point” for local youth.
- Developing your own personal project.
- Implementing other activities of the organization, like workshops, info-days, special events etc.
- Following the environmental schedule of the Youth Centre (cleaning of urban spaces, environmental actions etc.)
- Creation of other educational activities.
- Taking initiatives and proposing to the organization and the local youth new projects, fresh ideas etc. Developing of other projects on social, environmental and cultural issues.
- Participating in the language exchange workshops.

Volunteers are hosted in the youth hostel and guest house, two volunteers in each room. The hostel and the guest house are fully equipped with refrigerator, washing machine, vacuum cleaner, heating system, oven, plates, glasses, sheets, blankets, pillows.

The volunteer will receive: food allowance - every 1st of the month-->the volunteer will receive coupons for the supermarket by the Hosting Organisation pocket money allowance - every 15th of the month, the volunteer will be paid in cash by the Hosting Organisation The volunteer will receive the first money 2 weeks after her/his arrival and the last money on the last day of her/his ESC.
