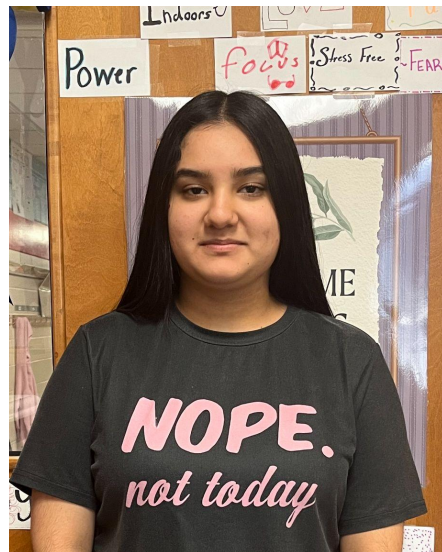

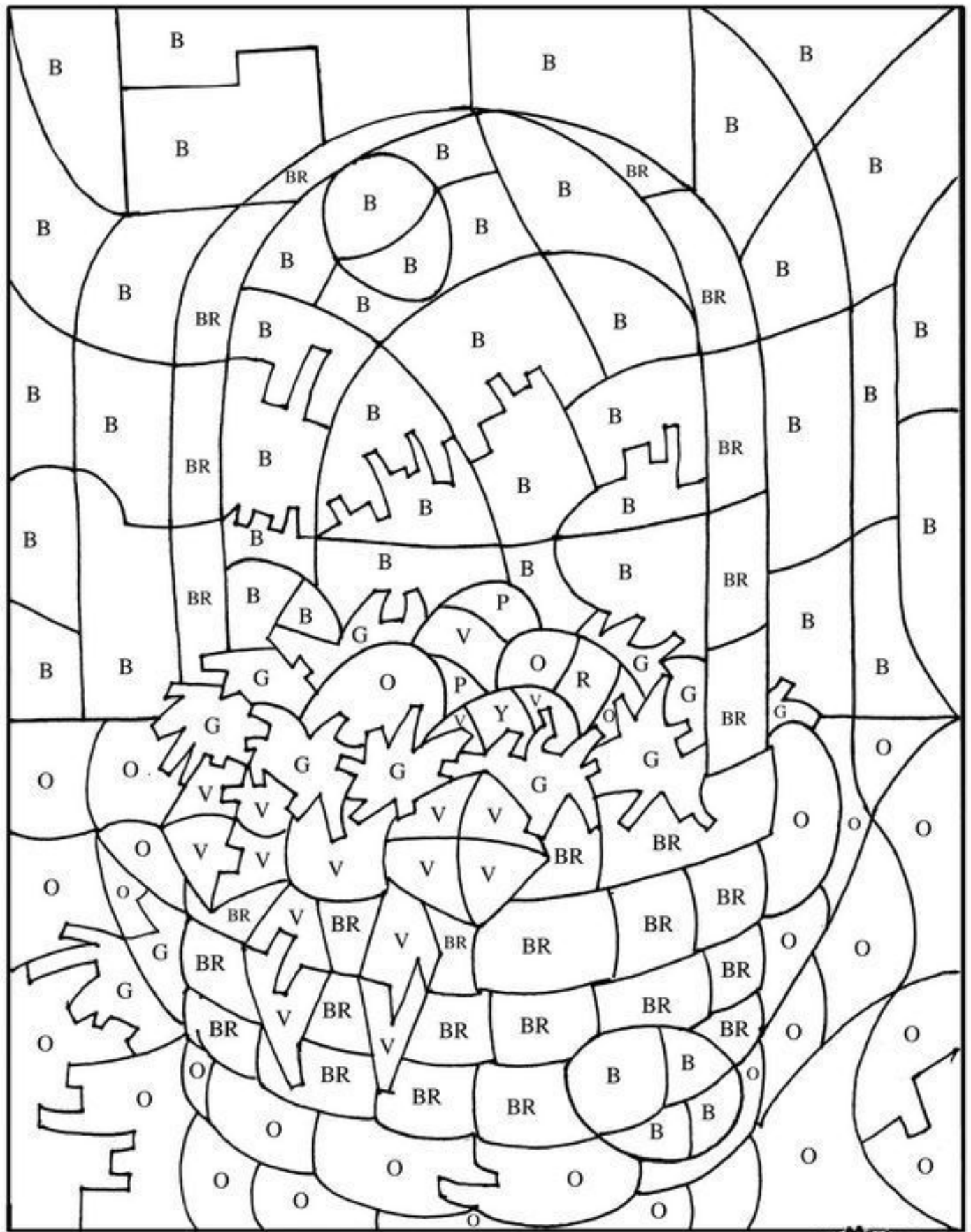
Awesome Teacher!
