Happy March friends! We will be kicking the first week of March off by learning all about the season of spring. Children will be playing spring BINGO, reading The Very Hungry Caterpillar, exploring plastic flowers in the sensory table as well as creating a colorful kite in art.

In the second week, we will focus on some of the spring holidays such as Easter, Passover and St. Patrick's Day. Your kiddos will explore rainbow water beads in the sensory table, go on an alphabet scavenger hunt, decorate tin foil Easter eggs and measure leprechauns!

Our class will learn all about the wetlands this week. The kiddos will be making lily pads and dragonflies in art, creating patterns using linking ducks in math as well as tracing wetland themed words in literacy.

Finally, during the last week of the month our classroom will be learning about the weather. Children will practice drawing circles for Mr. Sun, will make rainbow handprints, will trace various weather words, as well as conduct a wind blowing experiment!
