ADVENTURE TOPIC	How we'll explore...
<b>Creative Expressions: Art in Action</b> June 17-21	Campers will explore the visual arts, with experiences including mural-making, sculpture, action painting, collage, and the study of famous artists. The week will culminate with an art gallery celebration for families.
<b>Creative Expressions: Making Music</b> June 24-28	Campers will create their own instruments, including rain sticks and maracas, learn about the instrument families, and engage in STEM-related music activities. We will have a special visit from a Rockstarts musician as an in-house field trip!
<b>STEM: Wet n' Wild</b> July 1-5	Water takes center stage this week, as campers explore this key component of life through experiments and adventure. This week we will also celebrate the 4 <sup>th</sup> of July!
<b>Culinary Arts: Let's Get Cooking!</b> July 8-12	Campers will learn about healthy eating habits while having fun creating recipes to share with each other and their families. The week will culminate with a family potluck dinner!
<b>Going Places: Pack Your Bags!</b> July 15-19	Campers will fill their passports with imaginary adventures, exploring the world without ever leaving the school property! Campers will expand upon last week's culinary adventures by "cooking around the world," and will create a class photo album of their own families' travels.
<b>Going Places: Transportation</b> July 22-26	Let's make things go! Campers will learn about all forms of transportation, and make their own models of the forms of transportation. We will invite the fire department for an in-house field trip and truck touch as a culminating activity for this week!



# July 29 – August 30, 2019

ADVENTURE TOPIC	How we'll explore...
<b>Let's Pretend: Imagine That!</b> July 29 – August 2	Can you imagine a creature that hatches from an egg, has eight legs, and breathes fire...and glitter? Anything is possible when campers stretch their imaginations for this exploration area. This week will include in in-house "Library Storytime" full of imaginative books read by a local librarian.
<b>The Great Outdoors: Nature Explorations</b> August 5-9	Campers will explore the wonders of nature through gardening, nature walks, and examination of plants and animals. We will host an Audubon Society naturalist for an in-house field trip.
<b>The Great Outdoors: The Big Dig!</b> August 12-16	Campers will unleash their inner archaeologist through explorations of what's buried beneath the ground. Special attention will be paid to dinosaurs and prehistoric animals.
<b>STEM: Journey through the Solar System</b> August 19-23	Campers will look up into the sky and explore the stars and planets, and imagine what life outside of our world would look like. We will host a visit from a NASA scientist, to culminate this week's explorations.
<b>STEM: Let's Build!</b> August 26-30	Campers will spend a week exploring construction and architecture, building with a wide variety of materials, and learning how buildings and structures are made. This final week of camp will end with a Goodbye, Summer celebration for families!



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
