

Opportunities for Students Attending Brooke and Hancock County Schools

Applications for the following opportunities will be available January 1 and can be found on our website, <u>www.cfov.org.</u>

Aaron Davies Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from Weir High School
- Applicant must have been a member of WHS basketball team at least two years (grades 9-12)
- Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 with plans to attend a four-year college

David Robertson Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must reside in a county served by CFOV
- Applicant must be pursuing/plan to pursue an associate degree at any WVNCC campus and be enrolled next academic year
- HS senior applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 to apply; current WVNCC students must have a cumulative 2.5

Beulah Meyer Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of Weir High School or Weirton Madonna High School
- Must have resided in Weirton, West Virginia for four years or more
- Must have maintained a 3.0 GPA
- · Applicant must exhibit financial need

Frank Ferguson Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior at Brooke High School
- Must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA
- Applicant must be of high moral character

George Zatezalo Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior at Weir High School
- Must intend to major in physical sciences or education
- Must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0
- Must have completed four years of higher math or three years of chemistry

The Smaltz Family Scholarship – in Memory of Donald M. and Barbara P. Smaltz, Joan P. Rees and Ellen Patterson Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of Weir High School
- Must be pursuing higher education of some type
- Applicant must exhibit financial need

Jan Mayhew Graham Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of Oak Glen High School OR an active member or regular attendee of one of the following churches in upper Hancock County – Trinity Presbyterian, Westminster Presbyterian or New Cumberland First Presbyterian Church
- Applicant must be pursuing higher education of some type

Tikkun Olam Scholarship of Temple Beth Israel of Steubenville

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior attending Steubenville High School, Indian Creek High School, Weir High School or Brooke High School
- Applicants must plan to pursue a healing profession. The principle of Tikkun Olam challenges individuals to heal a broken world.
- A cumulative GPA of at least 3.2 is required and applicants must demonstrate financial need.

Howard Corcoran Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Student must attend an <u>OVAC school located in West Virginia</u>, but athletic involvement is not required
- Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at the time of application
- Student must plan to enroll in a two-year or four-year college or university following graduation
- Student must demonstrate a significant contribution to his or her community through volunteering or other types of community service

Ken Dennis Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior of an Ohio Valley high school, with preference given to Martins Ferry High School students
- Must pursue a degree in mathematics, science, or engineering
- Preference will be given to students pursuing a degree from Miami University (Ohio) or The Ohio State University

Mulholland Futures Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a youth from West Virginia pursuing any type of post-high school education (degree, licensure, certification)
- Applicant must be a current graduating senior or have obtained a high school diploma or GED/TASC within previous five years
- Preference extended to a youth in recent care at Youth Services Systems, Inc. (within previous five years), a youth of a current YSS employee
- Preference extended to applicants from the northern panhandle of West Virginia (Hancock, Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, Tyler or Wetzel counties)

Orrick, Herrington, Sutcliffe GOC Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior from an Ohio Valley high school
- Must have maintained a 3.5 GPA
- Applicant must plan to major in a business field emphasis on business management, accounting, or information technology

Jerome B. Schmitt Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must have graduated from a high school community in which there is a WesBanco Branch
- Must have maintained a 2.5 GPA
- Applicant must attend West Liberty University, majoring in a degree from the School of Business
- Applicant must exhibit financial need

John H. & Dorothy M. Zmavec Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must have graduated from a high school in Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, Wetzel or Tyler counties in West Virginia or Belmont or Jefferson counties in Ohio
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Applicant must plan to major in education (primary or secondary)
- Must have maintained a 2.5 GPA
- Scholarship awarded based on financial need, grades, and involvement in extracurricular activities

The Warren, Mary & Debbie Bennett Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating high school senior or enrolled college student from the tri-state area with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Must plan to attend a two-year or four-year college, trade school or certificate program
- Preference will be given to applicants who are current, baptized members of a Church of Christ located in the tri-state area
- For the purposes of this scholarship, tri-state area is defined as areas of West Virginia, Ohio and Pennsylvania generally considered to be located within a reasonable distance from Weirton, WV

The following funds are held at CFOV, but the affiliated scholarship opportunities operate outside the CFOV cycle.

Upper Ohio Valley Italian Foundation Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must be a resident of Hancock, Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, Tyler or Wetzel counties in West Virginia or Belmont or Jefferson counties in Ohio
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must have maintained a 3.0 GPA; minimum ACT composite score of 21 and/or a total SAT of 980

Rachael Worby Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior from the Upper Ohio Valley or a participant in Wheeling Symphony Youth Orchestra for at least two years
- Applicant must pursue a degree in music in the fall following high school graduation Inquire with the Wheeling Symphony for application information

The following CFOV opportunity is for students with 30 college credit hours and a minimum collegiate GPA of 2.2 (with a collegiate transcript) – there have been instances where graduating seniors have been eligible for this opportunity due to enrollment in dual-credit programming, etc.

AAUW Beulah Boyd Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Applicant must have completed 30 credit hours of college courses, with a minimum GPA of 2.2
- Must reside in Brooke, Ohio, or Marshall counties in West Virginia or Belmont County, Ohio
