It will not be possible to add/change competitors after the 20th of March

An active SportsID national federation account is mandatory to register.

6. Fee

The registration fee is **\$60 US Dollars** per participant/duo couple for all competitions an athlete takes part in.

7. Right To Participate and Categories

Athletes must be presented and registered by their National Federation-Ju-Jitsu National Organisation (JJNO), which is a JJIF / JJAFU member.

Based on the JJIF OSC 3.1, Paragraph § 3.2. Entries of Competitors: Each JJNO may enter up to **two (2) contestants** in each category for the Continental Championships. However, depending on the number of participants in each category, the





host JJNO, the Angolan Ju-Jitsu Federation may be entitled to enter up to **four (4)** contestants. Final decision of number of additional entrants for each category by the Angolan Federation rests with the JJAFU President after consultation with the JJAFU Sports Director.

a) Categories

The following age divisions¹ will be allowed to participate in this event

Name	Description	Year of birth for this event
Adults (+18)	Older than 18 years	2004 ² or older

Official JJIF Weight categories will be used³

8. Arrival/Transport

The Organizer will appoint the official hotels (see below) and will provide transport from international airport Aeroporto Intenacional 4 de Fevereiro to official hotels, from official hotels to competition venue and from official hotels to airport.

Please book your arrival and departure to and from Aeroporto Intenacional 4 de Fevereiro and inform the local organisors soonest of your arrival and departure days and time, airline, flight no etc.. and time and ask for confirmation that they have well received your information.

a) Entry and Visa for Angola

The Organizer is happy to help any country with obtaining a visa for athletes and officials. Please check with your relevant local authorities eg Ministry of Foreign Affairs of local travel agencies if you need VISA before arriving in Angola.

For nations, that need VISA to enter Angola, please send the Organizer as soon as possible a list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth and positions. (Add Passport Picture, please)

Complete visa applications should be sent to: luisjohn2015@gmail.com and africanjujitsu2022@hotmail.com.

Deadline for VISA support is March 10th

- after this date, you must take care of the VISA yourself, or additional costs will apply

9. Accommodation and Meals

The official hotels and budget accommodation are:

- Hotel Victoria Gardens (4*)
- Hotel Lukweku (3*)
- State-owned dormitory- can accommodate 70 persons

Participants who wish to stay at the above 2 hotels should **make their own booking directly** with the hotels or through online hotel booking sites and also make their own arrangements for their meal options directly with the hotels. The local organisor will also help you to make your booking. Please contact them for any information you need. Should

you find any other hotels but which have to be close to the competition venue, Arena do Kilamba, please contact the local organisor which will help and confirm that they may provide transport to and from these hotels as well.

Participants who wish to stay at the state-owned dormitory must inform the local organisor which will make the necessary arrangements. The State-owned dormitory is available at **US\$ 20 per night including breakfast only**. Payments have to be made to the local organizer. Participants must make their own arrangements for meals other than breakfast.

10. Covid-19 Tests

The Local Organizer through the Ministry of Health will provide tests for all Athletes.

- If one athlete has positive test results all his close contacts will be required to be tested (National Team).
- All Covid-19 Positive cases will be placed in quarantine until fully recovered.

11. Rules and Brackets

The brackets will be made in agreement with the Organisation and Sporting code⁴ and published on the Sportdata event page after the draw.

12. Coaches, Media & Medical personnel from JJNOs

a) Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). At least one Coach or Medic per JJNO must prove the participation in the coach seminar of WADA or a similar course⁶.

b) Medical personnel

JJNOs may have⁵ its own medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel please register via Sportdata.

At least one Coach or Medic per JJNO must prove the participation in the coach seminar of WADA or a similar course⁶

13. Referees

Qualified referees are very welcome at the event. A referee course and examination will be held for those who wish to undergo same.

14. Anti-Doping Test

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. If you have entered the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medication contains any substances on WADA's Prohibited List: (https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADO if you need a TUE and do not already have one. If you have any difficulty in applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, please contact jiji@ita.sport.

15. Liability

Neither the organizers of the event, nor the National Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any losses or damages to any property arising out of participations and travelling in connection with this championship.

Coaches and team leader are responsible to make sure that all participants are physically fit, prepared and capable to cope with championship.
