


Summer is here! As the warm weather approaches, children will be enjoying and learning all things summer!

We will be closed for the first week of July in observance of Independence Day and our summer break. Our last day of class will be Friday, June 28th and we will return Monday, July 8th.




Our theme for the first week back will be about beach days. Children will get creative in art and make art projects such as a beach ball painting, sandy starfish, pinching crab, a sand castle, and sand art. Using a marker, children will create a design onto a piece of blank



paper, then they will trace the line with glue, and sprinkle colored sand onto their design.

For our second theme of July we will be learning all about summer treats. From watermelon to dessert treats such as funnel cakes and ice cream, children will be dipping their toes into summer treat land! Children will also continue to work on their sight word of the week (what) by finding, tracing, writing, and using it in a sentence.



For our third theme of the month, children will be exploring all things ocean.



Children will get a chance to use the sensory table filled with water and ocean

animals and explore them through their natural habitat. Children will also be playing roll and cover shells for math. They will be given laminated mats with different seashells labeled with numbers 1-10. They will each take turns rolling a dice and coloring in the corresponding seashell until their mat is completed.

For our fourth and final theme for July, the children will be diving into the world of pirates.



Children will play a game of I Spy where they will be given small pictures of pirate related articles. Children must use their magnifying glass to figure out what the pictures are and what kind of day it is (i.e sunny, cloudy). Then they will discuss as a group the pictures they found.

Sunscreen Protection
