### Fun Project to Do with Your Kiddo

#### Earth Day Cookies



Simply separate regular sugar cookie  
dough in two and add blue gel food  
coloring to one and green to the oth-  
er. Let your child take a bit of dough  
from each color and roll it into a ball  
to make an earth. Place your mini  
earths on a cookie sheet and bake at  
350 for about 17 minutes. After tak-  
ing them from the oven immediately  
flatten them with bottom of a glass  
or a solid spatula. Enjoy!
